IFAA 2013 Shoot of the Year Awards went to Jodi Hicks, Maria Stacey, Faith Daniels, Sterlin McCormick, Andrew Hofstetter and Richard Fogler.

The rules are posted on the web site. The 2014 Indoor State will start the S.O.Y. for 2014. Indoor and Outdoor State Tournaments will be for 10 points will be awarded for 1st place down to 8th place. (10 points to 3 points)

For American, International, outdoor field, outdoor hunter, 3D and all 4 indoor districts will get 5 points max down to 2 points. For the International and 3D, point will awarded for members placement. The awards for Male and Female in Cubs, Male and Female Youth & Young Adult (combined) and Male and Female Adults. Six awards given out at the 2015 Indoor Tournament awards.
