Dear Archers:

The Indoor State Championship next year 2016 will be held at Kokomo Convention Center in Kokomo, In. on March 5 and 6, 2016, set up and practice on Friday.

IFAA 2014 Shoot of the Year Awards went to Brenda Dixon, Jordyn Smith, Faith Daniels, Sterlin McCormick, Harrison Milne, and Arnold Bischoff.

The rules are posted on the web site. The 2015 Indoor State will start the S.O.Y. for 2015. Indoor and Outdoor State Tournaments will be for 10 points will be awarded for 1st place down to 8th place. (10 points to 3 points)

For American, International, 3D and all 4 indoor districts will get 5 points max down to 2 points. For the International and 3D, point will awarded for members placement. The awards for Male and Female in Cubs, Male and Female Youth & Young Adult (combined) and Male and Female Adults. Six awards given out at the 2016 Indoor Tournament awards.

Thank you goes out to the Directors who helped at the Indoor State Tournament, also BIG THANKS to the members who help tear down and the setup of the shooting range, we appreciate all the help we had.

We had 6 PeeWee's 4 girls and 2 boys, 29 Cubs 8 girls and 21 boys; 15 Youths 7 girls and 8 boys and 21 Young Adults 7 girls and 14 boys, with 19 Officers shooting total of 222 shooters.

The 5 person traveling team trophy was won by NAK Outfitters, Inc. with a score of 1492 with 217 spots. We had 4 teams shooting for the traveling trophy. The 5 person is team with a minim of 2 female on it, regardless of age. 5 members any style, but you must have 2 female shooters. You can have a cub shooting 10 yds if you like. Basically 5 of your best shooters. The challenge is out
