Treasurer Report: Treasurer, Ben Rance went over the balance of accounts and discussed keeping the bale fund separate

- Checking balance \$15,926.04, Savings (Target Bale Fund) \$10,811.67 still need to pay for the remaining stands, \$6,300 of the balance came from the sale of the old bales
- Opened a new Checking account for the Stripe Funds to go to, balance \$3,045.27
- Total balance in all three accounts \$29,782.98

NFAA Director: Michael Arison

- Nationals is making it so that sky drawing is one warning at the beginning of the shoot and 2nd warning is a disqualification. If there are damages the shooter is to pay a fine. Suggesting we should follow suit.
- Michael reiterated that any and all changes need to be submitted to him to send to nationals. He is more than willing to submit ideas to keep making the program better.
- Great Lakes Outdoor Sectionals a Nationally sanctioned tournament – Michael would like to see Indiana hold a sectional
 - There are around 4-5 courses that could hold this tournament, thinking that the clubs holding the tournament could rotate around the state from year to year so each club could hold the tournament every 4-5 years.
 - It would be a 2-day tournament, 28/14 targets each day
- The double blocker in BHFS is legal – it was brought up that it is not but that is incorrect
- The novice class is still on the table, just working on some wording
- The NFAA is looking into having a booth at the Hoosier 690 indoor tournament
- The NFAA is sponsoring a target at the Hoosier 690 indoor tournament

- Mentioned that we need more bales but decided that it would be best to wait until there is a need, buy less at a time to spend less on shipping
- The need for another larger enclosed trailer would be needed before buying more targets
- Need to paint a 1 on one side and a 2 on the other to help each side to be used as equally as possible
- Need some sort of dolly to transport the targets to and from the trailer and something safe for turf

3D Indoor Committee: Tom Stricker, Joe Williams, Kyle Van Meter, Bob Webber as the advisor

- Bob Webber has this all written up and will email it to the Rob Garfield, Rob to email to secretary. Below are some of the rules/guidelines that were discussed and approved
 - This season will be a trial year – talk about this at the 2023 spring meeting
 - No stickers on targets
 - No home districts
 - No discount for officers or directors
 - Directors to reach out to local shops for scheduling and to see if they would want to hold a qualifier
 - Set up would be like ASA/IBO
 - Center 12, 10, 8, 5
 - Max yardage 50 yds, no minimum
 - Peewee class max yardage 15 yds
 - Known yardage, range finder friendly
 - 30 targets
 - Essentially same rules as outdoor 3D with modified wording
 - Secretary to make Treasury form
 - SOY
 - Combine outdoor & indoor SOY
 - No SOY for 2022, this is a trial year, if goes well then incorporate SOY
 - Qualifier
 - Gets preference for state registration
 - 4-6 clubs able to hold qualifiers (Shooter's, Cutting Edge, Bass and Bucks, Iroquois, Clubhouse)
 - Unlimited qualifiers can be held but only one per shop
 - Must be scheduled before the season starts to put on the calendar and so the secretary knows how many results to have
 - No awards
 - Club runs the shoot
 - \$30 fee - \$20 to club, \$10 to IFAA
 - State
 - \$40 fee - \$25 to club, \$15 to IFAA
 - Annually in February (2023 – February 10-12 at Cutting Edge)
 - Cutting Edge to hold the first qualifier as a test
 - Shooter's holding qualifier 1/21/23
 - Tom said he could hold 25 shooters per line
 - 1 line Friday night, 3 lines on Saturday, 2 lines on Sunday

 - Vote between Pine Hill and Iroquois, Iroquois won with majority vote
- Indiana Classic – June 25, 2023 – Iroquois
 - Vote between Iroquois and Koteewi, Iroquois won with a unanimous decision
- American Round – July 16, 2023 – Koteewi
 - Vote between Iroquois and Koteewi, Koteewi won with a unanimous decision
- Outdoor State – August 26 & 27, 2023 – Pine Hill
 - Vote between Jay County, Iroquois, and Pine Hill, Pine Hill won with majority vote
