Answers to some FAQ's:

- Our tournament is a two-day event. You **MUST** shoot both days to win money or trophies.
- Saturday will be a 60 arrow 5-spot round on the blue face, with X's counting as 6 points.
- Sunday will be a 30 arrow Vegas round, with X's counting as 11 points.
- You may only shoot in **one division** (i.e. Bowhunter or Freestyle).
- The Pro division is an **open** championship division, like the Vegas Shoot. You do **NOT** need an NFAA Pro card to enter.
- If you **have** an NFAA **pro card**, you **MUST** shoot in the Pro division.
- The **1st place winners** of 3 Pro divisions will receive a bonus payment **ON TOP OF** the payout in accordance with the NFAA

pay schedule (based upon 75% of entry fees collected per respective class).

- 6 of the open money divisions ("**Champion**" on the rcherz registration page) are eligible for a **\$250 winning bonus**: Adult Male Freestyle, Adult Female Freestyle, Senior Male Freestyle, Senior Female Freestyle, Barebow Recurve, and Bowhunter Freestyle. The winner of each class will receive \$250 **ON TOP OF** the payout in accordance with the NFAA pay schedule (based upon 50% of entry fees collected per respective class), **AS LONG AS** there are 3 participants in the class.
- There is **not** a separate young adult money division. Youth or young adults who wish to shoot for money may enter the Adult Money Division.
- The Bowhunter Freestyle Money division is a combined gender and age division. There is **not** a separate female or senior bowhunter money division.
- The Barebow Recurve Money division is a combined gender and age division. There is **not** a separate female or senior barebow recurve money division.
- We will break ties in **ONLY** the Pro and Money divisions by shoot off. The shoot-offs will take place immediately following the respective line time if necessary to determine who will win money, and in what order the money will be paid out.
- We will follow the NFAA class schedule for the age group and class designations. If your age and class combination is not available at registration, check the shooting classes chart.
- The 11:30 am line **WILL** fill up on Saturday. Register early if you prefer to shoot at that time.
- The Sunday schedule will be posted when you arrive at the tournament. Sunday's times will be **determined later** based upon registration numbers.
- Sunday assignments will be **peer grouped**.
- The **payouts** for the Pro and Money classes are based on the advertised entry fees: \$200 for pro and \$100 for money. The

online registration has **added 8%** to the entry fees to cover our fees to Rcherz, the ITAA for tablet rental, and Stripe processing.

- **Practice** is available Friday, December 6 from 4:00-9:00pm.
- Practice will be available Saturday on a **limited basis** during each shooting line and between each line time.
- Practice will be available Saturday evening during the team event at the conclusion of the 3:30pm line time.
- The **weekend practice pass** is available during registration for \$21.00. You may pay in person for practice for \$20.00 for the weekend, or \$10.00 per day to receive an unlimited number of targets.
