Answers to some FAQ's:

What's the format/schedule?

- Our tournament is a two-day event. You MUST shoot both days to win money or trophies.
- Saturday will be a 60 arrow 5-spot round on the blue face, with X's counting as 6 points.
- Sunday will be a 30 arrow Vegas round, with X's counting as 11 points.

Can I shoot at 7:30 in bowhunter and 3:30 in freestyle?

No.

• You may only shoot in **one division** (i.e. Bowhunter or Freestyle).

Which class is Pro? Which class is Money? Which class should I sign up for?

- The Pro division is an <u>open</u> championship division, like the Vegas Shoot. You do NOT need an NFAA Pro card to enter.
- If you <u>have</u> an NFAA <u>pro card</u>, you <u>MUST</u> shoot in the Pro division.
- The 1st place winners of 3 Pro divisions will receive a bonus payment ON TOP OF the payout in accordance with the NFAA pay schedule (based upon 75% of entry fees collected per respective class).
- 5 of the open money divisions ("Champion" on the rcherz registration page) are eligible for a \$250 winning bonus: Adult Male Freestyle, Adult Female Freestyle, Senior Male Freestyle, Senior Female Freestyle, and Bowhunter Freestyle. The winner of each class will receive \$250 ON TOP OF the payout in accordance with the NFAA pay schedule (based upon 50% of entry fees collected per respective class), AS LONG AS there are 3 participants in the class. There must be 5 participants in each class to receive the bonus and maintain money status. If less than 5, participants will be refunded the difference and moved down to the trophy class.
- There is **not** a separate young adult money division. Youth or young adults who wish to shoot for money may enter the Adult Money Division.
- The Bowhunter Freestyle Money division is a combined gender and age division. There is **not** a separate female or senior bowhunter money division.

How will winners be decided?

- Placement in all classes will be decided first by total score.
- Ties in <u>all</u> classes will stand <u>outside</u> of podium places.
- In the <u>trophy class only</u>, ties will be broken by total X-count to determine podium places. For <u>1st place only</u>, the shoot-off

- procedure will be enacted if necessary to determine the champion (if archers are tied on score AND X-count). Ties on x-count will remain for 2nd place and below.
- For the Pro and Money classes, the shoot-off procedure will be enacted to break ties of total score for the podium places only.
- We will follow the NFAA class schedule for the age group and class designations. If your age and class combination is not available at registration, check the shooting classes chart.

Should I register early?

- The 11:30 am line **WILL** fill up on Saturday. Register early if you prefer to shoot at that time.
- The Sunday schedule will be posted on Saturday. Sunday's times will be <u>determined later</u> based upon registration numbers.
- Sunday assignments will be **peer grouped**.

Why does registration charge me more than I thought?

 The <u>payouts</u> for the Pro and Money classes are based on the advertised entry fees: \$200 for pro and \$100 for money. The online registration has <u>added 8%</u> to the entry fees to cover our fees to Rcherz, electronic scoring costs, and Stripe processing.

When/how much is practice?

- Practice is available Friday, December 6 from 4:00-9:00pm, but there will be an S3DA event taking place from 7:30 onward, so practice will run on their line commands.
- Practice will be available Saturday on a limited basis during each shooting line and between each line time.
- Practice will be available Saturday evening during the team event at the conclusion of the 3:30pm line time.
- The **weekend practice pass** is available during registration for \$21.00. You may pay in person for practice for \$20.00 for the

weekend, or \$10.00 per day to receive an unlimited number of targets.
